Wangaay Out-of-Home Care (OOHC) Service is a partnership between Anglicare and Riverina Medical and Dental and Dental Aboriginal Corp (RIVMED). This service provides culturally appropriate OOHC case management to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children, young people and their carers.

The core mission of Anglicare (NSW South, West & ACT) is to break the cycle of intergenerational poverty for children, young people and families. We have a particular focus on serving vulnerable communities in the ACT and regional, rural NSW.

We are looking for two competent, professional individuals to join our expanding team. As a Case Manager, you will develop and implement case plans for children and young people in OOHC. You will work with families, foster carers and other professionals to achieve the best outcomes for kids in care.

The successful applicant will have experience working with children and young people with high support needs preferably in out of home care, demonstrated competencies in assessment and case management and excellent report writing skills. Tertiary qualifications and relevant experience in a human services setting is essential
